

SUPPLY LIST -- DOROTHY L. JOHNSON

BEGINNING OILS or ACRYLICS

- 3 canvas pieces, 8 x 10 minimum size
- A starter kit of paints in either medium with a range of hues (colors)
- Color wheel (optional), small size is OK
- 3 brushes minimum, large, medium and thin
- Paper towels, old rags, saran wrap to cover wet paintings, paper palette (comes in a pad)
- Some ideas for images to paint (there are many sources available in class)

FOR OIL PAINTERS *** IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE**

- Turpenoid (not turpentine) odorless
- Container to hold turpenoid
- Medium (Liquin preferred)
- Small jar to hold medium (pimiento or chopped garlic size)

Recommendation: If using canvas with wooden frames, place hanging eyes and wire on the back so that a wet painting can be handled without smearing or getting paint in your auto. There is storage space in the classroom for wet paintings if you chose to leave them at the Center.
