

Watercolor supplies

1.- Watercolors set – tubes.

I recommend a starter set like Reeves 18 or 24 tube set. Michaels or Blicks. But another set like Staedtler \$19.99. The Fine Touch set is not pigmented enough, if you have it use it but don't recommend it.

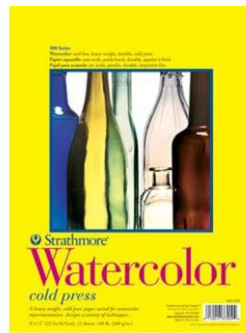
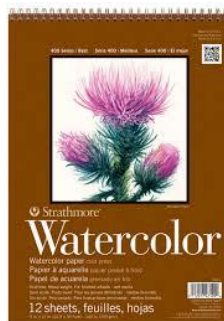
2. Plastic palette.

One with at least 20 wells. This style works well for me. It is \$5.99 at Hobby Lobby but you may find it cheaper at Blicks.



3. Watercolor Paper

A block or tablet of Canson XL 9" x 12" or 11" x 14" or Strathmore.



4. Brushes

Synthetic Taklon is a good overall brush for watercolors. Buy a set with multiple shapes some round, some flat and a couple small detail brushes.

5. Pencil – a 2B or 3B is best but a regular No.2 will be fine.

6. Eraser – a Magic White Prismacolor, Staedtler white or similar

7. Sharpener.

8. water container, paper towels, scrap paper, a board and painters tape are also useful items to have.
