PHOTOS OF ANIMALS YOU WOULD LIKE TO PAINT -

Good quality oil paints - I prefer Winsor & Newton and Holbein, professional paints

For starters:

French Ultramarine Blue

Burnt Umber

Burnt Sienna

Yellow Ochre

White, Titanium for flake

Alizarin Crimson

Cadmium Red Light

Cadmium Red Yellow

Sap Green

Cadmium Orange

Lemon Yellow

And any other colors you wish.....some lighter blues or lavenders, bring whatever you have.

Oil Painting medium - GAMBLIN, Galkyd Lite and GAMBLIN, Gamsol odorless mineral spirits
some students may have allergy problems so make sure you have "odorless" paint cleaners

Canvas, 16 x 20 or larger.....

I will be using 1 1/2" Gallery wrapped canvas from Cheap Joe's - 18 x 24 "
(for commission paintings I use Belgian Linen)

Brushes: Good assortment of bristle brushes. Flats, Rounds & filberts, have some small brushes for detail

Palette knife and palette for mixing paints

Cloth or paper towels for clean up

Containers for your mixing and clean up mediums

There will be a short demo with emphasis on composition and hand outs with plenty to think about. Try to have a light sketch done before our painting time,....filling up the canvas with your subject matter,....taking parts of your subject off to the edges of your canvas for better composition.

This will be a fun class producing great works!!!!
