UKULELE CAMP WITH ROGER BELLOW AND BERITA MARTIN

Aiken Center for the Arts is a place where the arts are celebrated as an opportunity to share, learn, and grow. Roger Bellow and Berita Martin are two people with unique gifts and talents to share. Partnering together, exciting programming is soon to come! Roger Bellow is a lifelong musician, with a wealth of professional experiences and a humble, kind way about him. He is an inductee of the Low Country Music Hall of Fame and a 1995 Recipient of the SC Arts Commission Jean Laney Harris Folk Heritage Award. He has served as an Artist in Residence for the South Carolina Arts Commission, instructing students in string and Folk music in schools throughout South Carolina, and has also worked at the Charles Town Montessori School and Trinity Montessori School as a Spanish and Music instructor. Additionally, Roger has owned and operated a music shop for thirty years, teaching lessons to students using a variety of string instruments. His partner, Berita Martin, has traveled and performed worldwide, with extensive knowledge of the Spanish language and experience in the travel and entertainment industry. Bringing together their gifts, Roger, and Berita, have given live performances for the Charleston County library system, Charleston County schools, and Charleston County Parks and Recreation Department, as well as co-authored a children's book, *Vamos Cantando* (Let's Go Singing) containing original songs.



Summer of 2021, Roger will teach a week-long ukulele camp infused with music, art, and language. Students will receive their own ukuleles, learn how to play through folk music and whimsical melodies in English and Spanish, and even have the opportunity to turn their ukulele into a personal work of art. Fall of 2021, Roger and Berita Martin, will teach students the Spanish language through interactive performances of original songs such as those contained in their children's book *Vamos Cantando* (Let's Go Singing).

Karen Brown and Aiken Center for the Arts keep the spirit of Joy in Journey alive during the pandemic

Meet Dance Theatre of Harlem ballerina and Augusta native Karen Brown, and learn how Karen has enabled Aiken Center for the Arts to adapt its Joy in the Journey program during the pandemic. Since 2017, Joy in the Journey at Aiken Center for the Arts has been connecting Aiken residents, with Alzheimer’s and dementia, with an art therapist who works with them to create an original painting through a joyful experience. However, the pandemic disabled Joy in the Journey sessions. So, in response to our program being cancelled by the pandemic, Aiken Center for the Arts joined with teaching artist Karen Brown to create a virtual movement and music program for those with Alzheimer’s and dementia. In this innovative program, Ms. Brown engages participants via Zoom using fundamental movements, conversation, singing, and music, stimulating both the body and the brain and providing a rewarding and meaningful experience. She brings her expertise and creative spirit to each session she leads. Currently an Assistant Professor of Ballet at the University of Missouri Kansas City Conservatory, Karen Brown also has experience as a professional ballerina with the Dance Theatre of Harlem and a teaching and directing career that spans the globe.

Karen’s resume is impressive in and of itself, but it is her personal experience of caring for her mother with Alzheimer’s that truly brought the spirit of our Joy in the Journey program to life. She recounts that what first felt like a great loss became an opportunity for communication beyond words. Communication with the mother she knew and loved could be unlocked through joyful or familiar movement, which had a way of bringing her mother back to her. Drawing upon these personal moments as well as her expertise, Ms. Brown now creates opportunities

for others with Alzheimer’s disease and dementia to connect and communicate. She articulates how her own experience relates to her current partnership with Aiken Center for the Arts. “As with my mother, the gift for me, throughout this program, is to learn how to communicate with the beautiful beings in front of me.” For Karen and Aiken Center for the Arts alike, this program is a matter of heart, and an opportunity for creative stimulation, connection, and soulful expression. Art and Music Camp

Offered at no cost to participating families, these camps are designed for those with traumatic brain injuries, cerebral palsy, and/or other physical and developmental disabilities. Camps are designed to allow these individuals to have a successful, joyful art experience by providing an opportunity to participate in both visual arts and musical activities at their own level. Camps are led by two instructors who are both SC Arts Access master teachers. Carter Boucher and Keith Tolan both have extensive experience teaching art to those with disabilities. Our curriculum is designed with multi-disciplinary content that optimizes each student's language, attention, memory, executive function and motor control functions.

Lasting Impact

For the individuals involved in the program, the benefits include the opportunity for a success-oriented creative outlet, social interaction with peers, and the positive self-esteem that comes from having their work displayed at the Art Center. These opportunities lead to the development of soft skills like communication, being part of a team or group, learning to make a decision, adaptability, leadership, kindness, independence, taking directions, empathy, and others.
