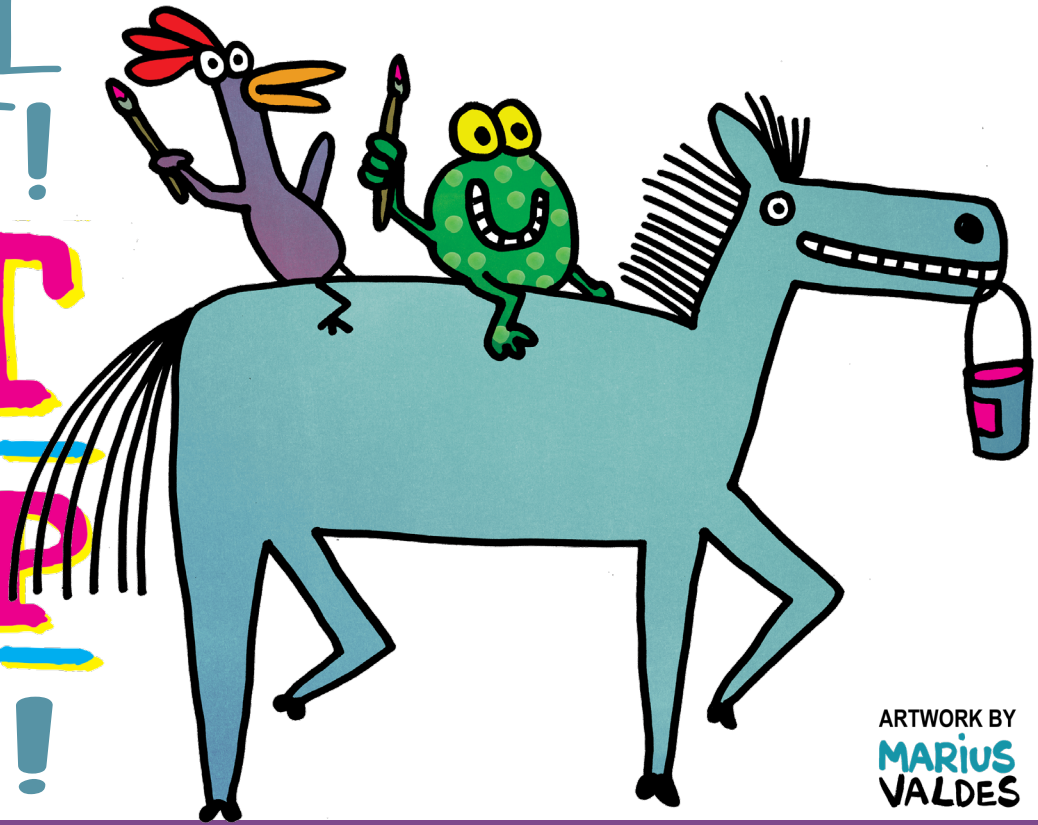

DISCOVERY ART CAMP AGES 5-7

Every day is an artistic adventure! Campers will create artwork inspired by people, far away places, animals and all the fun stuff in life. Children will experience drawing, watercolor, acrylic, pastels and 3-D art in a variety of individual and collaborative projects. Each week offers new and different projects.

ART CAMP AGES 8-10

Unleash that inner creativity! Campers will learn about masterpieces, famous artists, styles of art and how to find inspiration in everything! A variety of 2-D and 3-D projects offered. Individual and collaborative activities in many different mediums. Each week offers new and different projects.

ART STUDIOS AGES 11-14

Students will discover art through exploration of their favorite art mediums in a studio setting. Taught by artists working in their area of expertise, these studios allow participants to try different mediums throughout the year. Studio themes may include the following: Pottery, Comic/Anime, Sculpture, Watercolor Painting, Acrylic Painting, Textiles, & more!

DROP OFF & PICK UP: Doors open 15 min prior to camp start. Parents/Guardians sign campers in and check campers out daily. When camp ends, campers will be brought down to the first floor. If you will be late, please let us know. **CLOTHING:** Please make sure your child wears clothing appropriate for art camp - we will get messy! **SNACKS:** Students should plan to pack a snack and a drink for our mid-morning break. Please make sure your child's name is clearly labeled. No soft drinks or peanut products please.

SCHOLARSHIPS

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Early registration is recommended to secure a place in a class. We will gladly accept your registration up until class time IF we are able to accommodate you (space, materials, etc.). There is a 5% processing fee for each online registration.

CANCELLATION

If you cancel your registration after it has been processed, but at least a week before the class begins, we will refund your class fee less \$10. If you cancel with less than one week notice, no refund will be given. ACA reserves the right to cancel classes with low enrollment. If we must cancel a class, we will issue a full refund.

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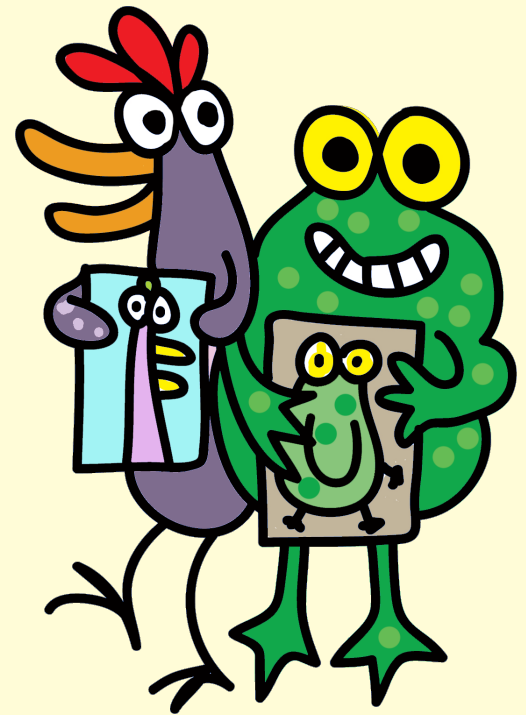
